# **Admission Policy Diploma Programme**

# **I. Admission requirements for Junior high School graduates (first year of a three-year high school system) and Elementary School graduates (first year of a four-year high school system)**

1. Junior high school graduates and Elementary school graduates who want to apply for admission to class I (pre-IB DP) need to submit the following documents:

- a) Application and personal data form submitted within the time limit set by the Board of Education for Wielkopolska region.
- b) Two photos
- c) Parents' permission (in writing) to enrol in the pre-IBDP class
- d) Junior high school final report/ Elementary school final report
- e) Final junior high school exam results/Elementary school exam results

2. Additionally, candidates to the class preparing for the IB Diploma Programme have to take the English language entrance exam (written part).

3. Points granted for the English language entrance exam (essay): max. 20 points

4. To be admitted to the pre-IBDP class, the candidate must obtain points for both stages of the admissions procedures:

- the entrance exam : **max. 20 points**
- final grades on the junior high school report as well as junior high school exam results (points calculated according to the guidelines from the President of the Board of Education for Wielkopolska Region, including points appointed for voluntary and sports activities/achievements): **max. 200**

5. Exam papers and assessment criteria are prepared by school examiners. The following students do not need to take the entrance exam (get the maximum number of points):

- students who have language certificates: FCE (First Certificate in English), CAE (Certificate in Advanced English), CPE (Certificate of Proficiency in English), TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), TELC (The European Language Certificates, at least B1 level). Original documents have to be submitted.

- finalists and laureates of the English language national competition (Olimpiada) and English subject competition winners (at least regional level )
6. Absentees at the exam will not be admitted to the pre-IBDP class.
  7. All the recruitment procedures are implemented by the School Recruitment Committee appointed by the Headmaster.
  8. Exam results will be announced within the deadline set by the Board of Education.

## **II. Admission requirements for IB Diploma candidates**

### **II Liceum Ogólnokształcące students, students coming from other schools (the second year of the three-year high school system or the second year of a four-year high school system), or candidates from abroad**

The following admission requirements must be completed before a student may be officially enrolled at II Liceum Ogólnokształcące im. Tadeusza Kościuszki.

1. Only the students who meet the following criteria will be admitted to the IB DP class (2<sup>nd</sup> year in the school system):
  - a) At least grade 4 or above in subjects chosen in the first year( both standard and higher level) or a grade 5 or above at Mathematics HL and Physics
  - b) The absence rate is not higher than 30% (on subjects of both standard and higher level).
2. If a student does not meet the requirements, he/she has to take an exam to be admitted to the IB Diploma programme ( the second year of the high school). At least grade 4 or higher in subjects chosen on both standard and higher level or 5 or above at Mathematics HL and Physics must be obtained. Additionally, a student must obtain at least grade 4 for general behaviour.

3. Students applying from other Polish schools have to take the English language written entrance exam.
4. Students applying from abroad have to take written exams at English , Polish and Mathematics. Each such case will be considered separately.
5. A student can be expelled from the IB Diploma programme if he/she is not involved in either CAS or TOK programs and/or does not intend to write the Extended Essay.
